



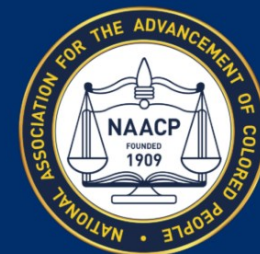
About Greater Texarkana Branch
